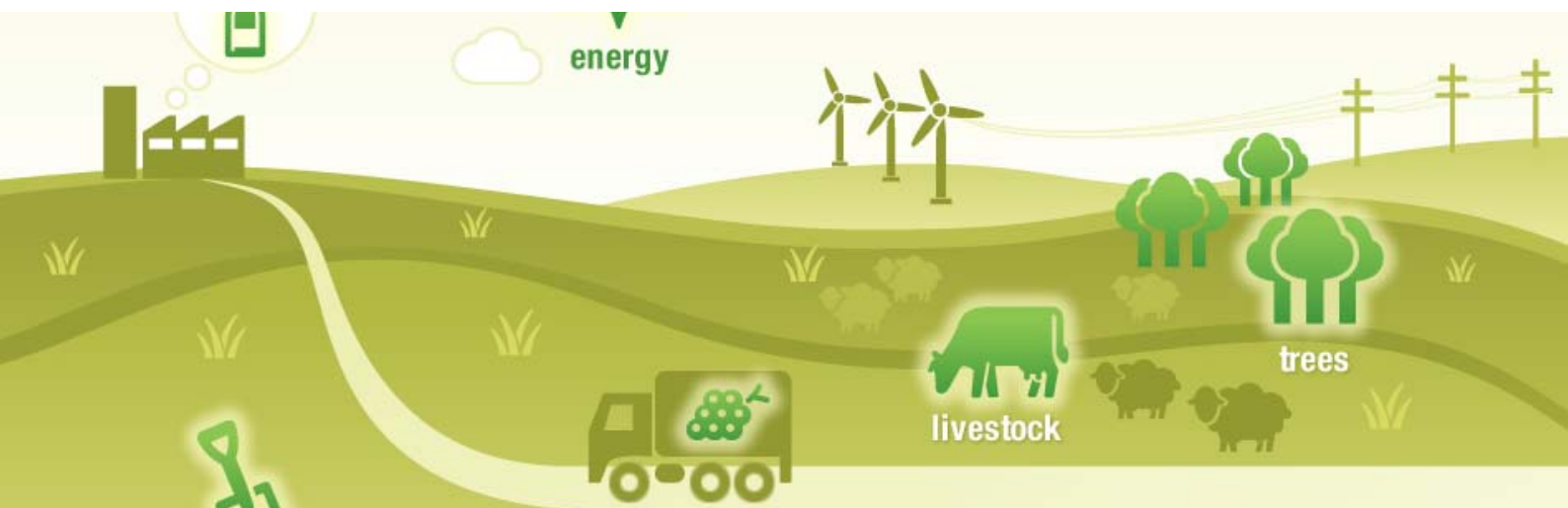


Invitation - DPI Climate Webinar Series 2012
